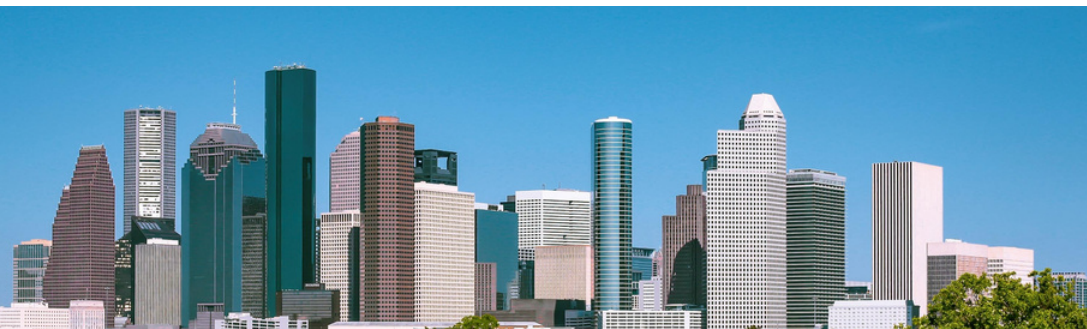
NOVEMBER EDITOR OF THE MONTH

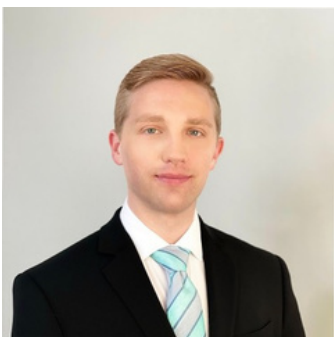
